# MARLIN MODEL

Individual parts are assigned a group number. The first number identifies the part and is shown above. A subgroup number following the decimal identifies parts which are similar. Example: Group 1 055 Head, Cylinder main group "1" indicates an engine part. Sub group "055" indicates the head group within the main group. This combination of numbers is shown in "Partners Group". When a part is listed in a group other than its primary group, the part will have the primary group noted in the column provided for its adjustment in the part number. This "Partners Group" is the number under which the part is listed, ordered and stored. All parts should be ordered by their identifying primary group number, part number and item name.

PARTS LISTED IN THIS CATALOG FOR SERIES 65 10 OR FOR MODEL 65 19 CAN BE ASSUMED TO BE APPLICABLE TO THE 65 59 MARLIN UNLESS OTHERWISE NOTED IN THE SPECIFIC GROUP.

### EFFECTIVE POINT OF CHANGE

When changes in body parts are introduced in production and the only used change part of a model year, reference is made to these changes by notes printed at the bottom of the pages on which the group heading appears. These notes give the car body number, car code number, car building sequence number, engine code number or body number at which the change became effective. When these numbers are not available at any company, a note containing a physical description will be used.

### CAR IDENTIFICATION

Each car produced in American Motors is identified by the following descriptions and location codes:  
The serial number is located on a plate attached to the top of the right front wheelhouse panel under the hood.  
Engine code number is stamped on a metal surface at the left front upper corner of the cylinder block. On the 1965 and 1966 it is stamped on the right upper side of the block. On Models 65 the 65 34-67 the 65 10 (7-3) and 65 01 (7-8) the number is stamped on the rear of the cylinder mounting bracket.  
Car code number, car building sequence number, body number, model number, part number and paint number are stamped on a plate attached to the body pillar, visible when the left front door is open.
